The Stanislaus County Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility is located at 1716 Morgan Road in Modesto and is open Fridays and Saturdays 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., excluding major holidays. There are also mobile collection events in different parts of the County. You can see the schedule and also more information about the facility including lists of toxic materials and safe handling at www.co.stanislaus.ca.us. Click on "Living and Working" and then on "Protecting the Environment." You will also see a link there for Recycling and Trash information. Some of the information is available in Spanish.

There is also a recycling guide for the City of Modesto. The link is difficult to navigate to from the home page; you can find it at www.modestogov.com/prnd/recycling/default.asp.

The City of Turlock site has recycling links at the bottom of the home page www.cityofturlock.org.

Most areas of the County have curbside collection service for used oil available to customers who have individual trash service. (Note that this is not available to residents of multifamily housing with dumpster service.) Residents must use their own containers: plastic jugs with tight-fitting screw-top lids. They should be labeled "Oil." (This can be done with a marker on masking tape.) These are left on the curb for pick-up on the regular trash day.
